سخنی با همکاران

پس از تدوین سند تحول وزارت آموزش و پرورش و استقرار ساختار جدید آموزشی، سازمان آموزش و پرورش استثنایی نیز همگام با سایر بخش‌های وزارت آموزش و پرورش اقدام به برنامه‌ریزی برای تحقق اهداف سند تحول نموده است. در این راستا، مطابق با اهداف پیش‌بینی شده در برنامه درسی ملی و به منظور کیفیت‌بخشی به آموزش و پرورش دانش‌آموزان با نیازهای ویژه و تحقق عدالت آموزشی و بهبود محتوا و روش‌های آموزشی، در گام نخست کتاب‌های درسی بررسی و ارزشیابی شد. سپس کتاب زبان انگلیسی با توجه به یافته‌های علمی و نیازها و ویژگی‌های دانش‌آموزان دوره اول متوسطه پیش‌حرفه‌ای تألیف شد. امیدواریم با آموزش مناسب این کتاب شاهد پرورش استعدادها و توانمندی‌های دانش‌آموزان عزیز باشیم.

برای پیشبرد بهتر و تکمیل فرایند یاددهی-یادگیری مراجعه همکاران محترم به کتاب راهنمای معلم الزامی است. در ادامه ساختار کتاب به صورت مختصر معرفی می‌شود. شرح مبسوط مطالب در کتاب راهنمای معلم آمده است.

۱. تصویر عنوانی

تصویر عنوانی فضای کلی هر درس را ارائه می‌کند. هدف از تصویر عنوانی ارائه کلی محتوای هر درس و آماده‌سازی ذهن دانش‌آموزان و آشناسازی آنها با مفاهیم آن درس است. پیش از شروع هر درس، معلم با توصیف و ارائه سناریوی درس، انگیزه دانش‌آموزان را برای یادگیری تقویت می‌کند. به این ترتیب توجه دانش‌آموزان گاه به کلیات و گاه به جزئیات تصاویر جلب می‌شود و آگاهی بهتری نسبت به محتوای هر درس پیدا می‌کنند.

۲. متن درس

متن هر درس با تصویر مرتبط و حباب سخن برای دانش‌آموزان ارائه شده است. در این بخش، واژگان هدف در تصویر به صورت موضوعی آورده شده‌اند و سپس به منظور توجه بیشتر دانش‌آموزان به محتوا، نگاره‌هایی نیز به همراه واژگان آورده شده است. برای آشنایی بهتر دانش‌آموزان با داستان کتاب، در هر درس شخصیت‌ها به صورت جداگانه معرفی شده‌اند. لذا آشنایی دانش‌آموزان با نام و تصویر شخصیت‌ها ضروری است.

۳. تمرین

برای توجه به سبک‌های مختلف یادگیری دانش‌آموزان تمرین‌های متنوعی طراحی شده است. صورت دستوری برخی از تمرین‌ها به این قرار است: گوش کنید و تکرار کنید؛ گوش کنید و انجام دهید؛ گوش کنید و بنویسید؛ حروف مشخص را پیدا کنید و دور آنها خط بکشید؛ تصاویر را به حروف ابتدایی‌شان وصل کنید؛ جای خالی اعداد را پر کنید. دانش‌آموزان پس از انجام تمرین به صورت انفرادی، باید در گروه‌های دو یا چندنفره تمرین‌ها را تکرار کنند.

۴. حروف

در هر درس دو حرف به صورت کوچک و بزرگ به دانش‌آموزان آموزش داده می‌شود. تأکید بر این است که در ابتدا نگاره‌های واژه‌های مرتبط معرفی می‌شود تا دانش‌آموزان مفهوم هر واژه را درک کنند. پس از گوش دادن و تکرار کردن دانش‌آموزان به استفاده از حروف در واژگان در قالب «گوش کنید و آواز بخوانید» می‌پردازند.

در بخش تمرین مربوط به حروف، دانش‌آموزان نخست فعالیت‌های فردی را در قالب مهارت شنیداری، وصل کردن تصاویر و بلندخوانی حروف تجربه می‌کنند. سپس فعالیت‌هایی را در قالب کار گروهی انجام می‌دهند. در بخش تمرین نوشتاری الگوهای صحیح نوشتاری حروف تدریس شده به صورت بزرگ و کوچک آورده شده است. به منظور تدریس نوشتار حروف، نحوه چرخش دست برای نوشتن هر یک از حروف آورده شده است و از دانش‌آموزان خواسته شده است پس از ردیابی حروف اقدام به نوشتن هر حرف کنند. در بخش نوشتن، دانش‌آموزان پس از ردیابی و تمرین نوشتن حروف به صورت مستقل، می‌توانند جاهای خالی برخی از واژه‌ها را نیز با حروف مناسب پر کنند.

۵. اعداد

اعداد انگلیسی از صفر تا ده به ترتیب مشخصی در کتاب آموزش داده می‌شوند. در هر درس حداقل دو عدد به دانش‌آموزان تدریس می‌شود. دانش‌آموزان پس از گوش دادن و تکرار کردن و شمارش و دایره کشیدن دور عدد درست به سمت انجام فعالیت‌های دو نفره هدایت می‌شوند. در بخش تمرین نوشتن عدد، نحوه چرخش دست و توالی حرکت‌های دست مهم است. صورت تلفظی و نوشتاری اعداد به صورت تک‌نفره و گروهی در قالب تمرین‌های متنوع تمرین می‌شود.

۶. خود ارزیابی

هدف خودارزیابی این است که دانش‌آموزان بتوانند با قضاوت در مورد مطالب آموخته شده حس ارزشمندی و اعتماد به نفس بیشتری نسبت به خود پیدا کنند و انگیزه یادگیری زبان انگلیسی در آنها تقویت شود. به این ترتیب دانش‌آموزان با درج علامت ✓ می‌توانند دانسته‌های خود را تأیید کنند و با انجام تمرین‌های بیشتر نسبت به برطرف کردن نقاط ضعف خود اقدام کنند.

۷. بخش مروری

به منظور تعمیق یادگیری و بررسی دوباره مطالب فراگرفته شده، در انتهای هر دو درس بخش مروری آورده شده است تا دانش‌آموزان به تمرین مجدد مطالب بپردازند.

۸. فرهنگ تصویری

در بخش پایانی کتاب تمامی واژه‌ها و جمله‌ها به صورت فرهنگ تصویری ارائه شده است.

۹. فهرست دستورکارها

برای استفاده بهتر معلمان گرامی تمامی دستورکارهای کتاب به صورت الفبایی همراه با ترجمه آنها ارائه شده است.

۱۰. متن بخش صوتی

متن تمامی فایل‌های صوتی نیز در انتهای کتاب آمده است.
